THE CHILD MUST BE SECURED IN A REARWARD FACING CHILD RESTRAINT

#### 6 MONTHS -UNDER 4 YEARS

THE CHILD MUST BE SECURED IN A FORWARD FACING CHILD RESTRAINT

#### 4 - 7 YEARS

THE CHILD MUST BE SECURED IN A FORWARD FACING CHILD RESTRAINT OR BOOSTER SEAT

## **CHILD RESTRAINT GUIDELINES USA**

Please be aware that we do not allow any children under the age of 4 years old to travel in our Beeva, Hitop or Kuga Campervans!

Each state in the USA has different laws in place. It remains the renter's responsibility to adhere by that state's guidelines.

Below are guidelines only and may change based on state law at any time.
